APA lists the following options (p. 44): Sans serif fonts such as 11-point Calibri, 11 point-Arial, 10-point Lucida, Serif fonts such as 12-point Times new Roman, 11-point Georgia or 10-point Computer Modern. (A serif font is one that has caps and tails - or "wiggly bits" - on it, like Times New Roman.

Including page numbers in all other circumstances is not required however, it is best practice to do so when referring to part of a work (e.g. a paragraph or chapter in a book).

APA in-text citation style uses the author's last name and the year of publication, for example: (Field, 2005). For direct quotations, include the page number as well, for example: (Field, 2005, p. 14). For sources such as websites and e-books that have no page numbers, use a paragraph number, for example: (Field, 2005, para. 1).
