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Frame #1 - Basic Sentences for Describing People. The first three sentence frames we will look at are simple sentences. One of the most common ways to describe people is with adjectives: tall, short, fat, skinny, pretty, handsome, ugly. To use these common adjectives in a sentence, try this frame: The man is [ADJECTIVE]. The man is tall. The man is fat.
